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#### 1. Purpose

This policy letter provides interim guidance to ensure Department of Marine Administration to comply the system of adherence to IMO recommendations that will assist in implementation and enforcement of the flag state requirements.

All divisions of Department of Marine Administration shall use this interim guidance in the system for adherence to IMO recommendations ( non-mandatory instruments ) that will assist in the implementation and enforcement of the requirements in the instruments.

Myanmar is contracting state to most of the international maritime Conventions. As the flag state, port state and costal state, Department of Marine Administration is the focal department to ensure the implementation and enforcement of the requirements in the IMO instruments.

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## 5. Processes

Legal and Technical standard division shall collect the all of the IMO recommendations ( non-mandatory instruments ) and circulate to the other divisions to make the implementations.

Nautical and Marine Engineering divisions have to study the IMO recommendations and find out any changes and additional requirements. Based on the finding, ND and MED have to consider the outcome relating to the existing system. Reviewing the outcome, ND and MED have to revise the concerning system, standard and procedure. Those revised system, standard and procedure have to be submitted to Director General to approve.

After receiving approval, ND and MED have to implement as issuing work instructions and guidance in accordance with approval.
